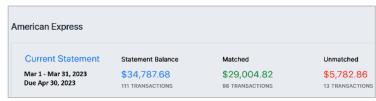
How Does PivotEQ Automate Credit Card Reconciliation?

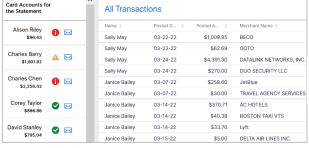
24/7 Comparison Between Card Statement and Expense Reports

The credit card statement is imported into PivotEQ and used to match transactions to expense reports. Once the final approval is made in SAP Concur, Pivot imports Concur Expense reports throughout the month. Once imported, the comparison begins – and continues automatically.

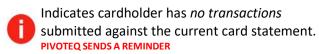
Designates Transactions as Matched or Unmatched in Real Time

PivotEQ continuously compares the credit card statement to expense reports. Transactions remain in the Unmatched group until found on an expense report. Cardholders with Unmatched transactions receive reminder emails.





EMAIL REMINDERS SCHEDULED THROUGHOUT THE MONTH TO CARDHOLDERS WITH OUTSTANDING TRANSACTIONS





Indicates cardholder has *some transactions* submitted against the current card statement – *but not all*.

PIVOTEQ SENDS A REMINDER



Indicates cardholder has submitted *all transactions* associated with the current card statement.

PIVOTEQ DOES NOT SEND A REMINDER



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Intelligent Accounting Creates Journal Entries

Simple Accounting is where the segments in the GL string are constant values. Because these values are generic, they're not very accurate.

Examples include 'Uncategorized Expense' for Expense Account – or – for the Cost Accounting segment, 'Unspecified Department' for Department.

Intelligent Accounting is where, instead of using constants, PivotEQ calculates the segments in the GL string. This leverages data in the Concur expense reports to make intelligent choices, for example, Expense Accounting and Cost Accounting.

The result is more accurate segment values.

For example, Intelligent Accounting calculates the Natural Account based on past assignments for Natural Accounts to merchants. It gains insight with every expense assignment – so the more expense reports – the better PivotEQ can accurately determine the correct Natural Account for a given merchant.
